WHAT IS AN EBOOK?

Only one ebook format is available: EPUB.

The EPUB format is designed to make on-screen reading easier. Its main advantage is dynamic reflow, meaning the layout of the text automatically adjusts when you change the font size.

That way, **screen size is no longer an issue**. EPUB adapts seamlessly to whichever device you're using: smartphone, e-reader, tablet, or computer.

HOW TO DOWNLOAD YOUR EBOOK

To fully access your file, you need an **Adobe ID**, which you can create by [clicking here](#). *Do not create an account using Google, Facebook or Apple.*

Creating an Adobe ID allows you to share your ebook on up to six devices registered to the same account.

When downloading a book protected by Adobe, you will not receive an EPUB file directly. Instead, you will obtain a file called URLLink.acsm, which must be opened with compatible reading software to access your ebook. On a computer, **Adobe Digital Editions** will create an EPUB file when you add the book to the software and place it in a folder called My Digital Editions.

URLLink.acsm files expire after two years. If they are not opened within this period, you can contact the online store's customer service directly.

- **Downloading Adobe Digital Editions on a computer**

You can download the **Adobe Digital Editions** software directly from the Internet.

Once the software is installed, you must authorise your computer using your Adobe ID.

- In Adobe Digital Editions, click "Help".
- Select "Authorize Computer", then enter your email address and password.

Next, add your ebook file as follows:

- In Adobe Digital Editions, click "File".
- Select "Add to Library" and locate your URLLink.acsm file (on Windows, filter the search using "Adobe Content Server Message").

- The ebook will then be added to, and readable in, Adobe Digital Editions. An EPUB file will also be created in the My Digital Editions folder.

- **Downloading Adobe Digital Editions on a phone or tablet**

To read your ebook on a mobile device, you can install **PocketBook Reader**, available on Android and iOS. If you download your ebook on a mobile device, you will find your URLLink.acsm file in the Downloads app on Android or the Files app on iOS. You will then need to choose to open the file with **PocketBook Reader**.

- **Downloading Adobe Digital Editions on e-readers**

If you have an e-reader with web browser access, you can visit <https://boutique.laventure.michelin.com/> directly on the device. You will first need to set up your Adobe account (Adobe ID) on the e-reader. You can then download your ebooks directly, and they will appear in your Library.

Transferring from a computer: You can transfer your ebooks from Adobe Digital Editions to your e-reader following these instructions.

- Connect your e-reader to your computer with the power on and Adobe Digital Editions open.
- The e-reader will appear in the software.
- You will then need to “Authorize Device”.
- Right-click on your ebook and select “Add to Device” to transfer it.

FILE PROTECTION

What is a URLLink.acsm file? This is the file that allows you to download your EPUB file protected by Adobe DRM directly using reading software such as Adobe Digital Editions (abbreviated “ADE”).

Open the .acsm file with ADE, and your ebook will download automatically.

READING AN EBOOK

You can read an ebook on multiple devices (*the same book can be read on several devices*):

- **Using an e-reader**

An e-reader is a device specifically designed for reading ebooks, perfectly suited for this catalogue (textbooks in black and white). Its electronic ink reduces glare and consumes very little power.

It is the preferred device for avid readers, and making it less likely to be distracted by other applications. It makes it possible to store ebooks, adjust the font size, navigate through links, and add bookmarks, among other features.

There are several ways to add a downloaded ebook to an e-reader:

1. Directly on the e-reader if it has internet access and a browser (enter the website address in the e-reader's browser).
2. Via a computer by transferring the downloaded files either through a USB cable or over a Wi-Fi network.

- **Using a computer**

Ebooks can be stored and read on a computer either through a downloaded application or via an online browser (with a plug-in).

Some examples of applications available for computers include:

- Thorium Reader (on PC)
- Radium plug-in on Chrome browser
- Adobe Digital Editions
- iBooks (Mac)

You should now be able to download and read your ebooks on the device of your choice. The support team remains available to assist you with downloading via the Contact section of the online store.
